



## 12 Day Classic Namibia Safari

*Windhoek - Mariental - Sossusvlei - Swakopmund - Damaraland - Etosha South - Etosha East*  
 12 Days / 11 Nights



## Introduction

Explore the bare plains of the Namib Desert, the apricot-coloured dunes of Sossusvlei, the romantic coastal town of Swakopmund nestled between the Ocean and the Desert, the rough terrain of Damaraland and the abundant wildlife in the world renowned Etosha National Park on this classic Namibia tour.

## Itinerary

### Day 1: Windhoek

Arrival in Windhoek and subsequent transfer to your accommodation. Your guide will meet you this afternoon and will conduct an orientation city tour of Namibia's capital.

#### **Overnight at Villa Violet Guesthouse or similar**

*Activities included: orientation city tour*

*Meals included: none*

### Day 2: Windhoek – Kalahari

Depart for the Kalahari semi-desert, where you arrive in the early afternoon. Later today we enjoy a sundowner drive on the lodge property.

#### **Overnight at Bagatelle Kalahari Lodge or similar**

*Activities included: sundowner drive*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

### Day 3: Kalahari – Namib Desert

The routing takes you further south via Maltahöhe into the low plains of the Namib Desert to Desert Camp, which is located nearby the entrance gate to the Sossusvlei dunes.

#### **Overnight at Desert Camp or similar**

*Activities included: none*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

### Day 4: Namib Desert

Very early departure today into the Namib Naukluft Park to witness one of Namibia's most scenic attractions - the Sossusvlei and the highest dunes of the world. Visit the nearby Deadvlei, a dried out natural water pan with its dead acacia tree trunks rising to the blue sky.

The Sesriem Canyon is another attraction worthwhile seeing en route back to the lodge. A relaxing sundowner on top of the nearby ridge ends off an unforgettable day in the desert.

#### **Overnight at Desert Camp or similar**

*Activities included: Visit to Sossuvlei, Dead Vlei & Sesriem Canyon*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

### Day 5: Namib Desert – Swakopmund

The route takes you north via the Kuiseb Canyon to Swakopmund. This quaint desert town with its old-world charm and relaxed atmosphere hedged by desert and sea, is enhanced by lush green lawns and palm trees.

#### **Overnight at Swakopmund Guesthouse or similar**

*Activities included: none*

*Meals included: breakfast*

**Day 6: Swakopmund / Walvis Bay**

A marine cruise has been booked for you today. You will be picked up at your accommodation and driven to the nearby town of Walvis Bay, from where your marine cruise departs. To round the trip off you will be spoilt with fresh Walvis Bay oysters, snacks and cold sparkling wine on board as you make your way back to the docking station and then back to Swakopmund.

**Overnight at Swakopmund Guesthouse or similar**

*Activities included: Marine Cruise*

*Meals included: breakfast*

**Day 7: Swakopmund – Damaraland**

Departure from Swakopmund along the Atlantic Coast towards the North.

Visit the lichen fields near Wlotzka's Baken before continuing to Henties Bay, a small holiday resort.

Onwards to the seal colony at Cape Cross. After visiting the seals, the journey continues via Uis towards Twyfelfontein.

**Overnight at Malansrus Tented Camp or similar**

*Activities included: Cape Cross seal colony*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

**Day 8: Damaraland**

Experience the desert-adapted elephants in the Huab and Aba-Huab dry riverbeds this morning with your guide. In the afternoon pay a visit to the Twyfelfontein Rock engraving, a world heritage site.

**Overnight at Malansrus Tented Camp or similar**

*Activities included: Elephant drive in touring vehicle & Twyfelfontein Rock Engraving*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

**Day 9: Damaraland – Southern Etosha National Park**

Leaving Malansrus we travel to Kamanjab and further to the Etosha National Park. The Etosha National Park presents to its guests a wilderness experience that is unmatched in terms of privacy and landscape viewing. If time permits, your guide will drive into the National Park with you already this afternoon for a game drive.

**Overnight at Etosha Village or similar**

*Activities included: Excursion to Etosha National Park in touring vehicle (time-permitting)*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

**Day 10: Southern Etosha National Park**

Discover the mysteries of the African bush in Etosha National Park whilst travelling in an eastern direction through the park. We spend the day doing game drives in the park and visit the numerous waterholes that attract a large diversity of animal and bird species, many of these being endemic to the country.

**Overnight at Etosha Village or similar**

*Activities included: Excursion to Etosha National Park in touring vehicle*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

**Day 11: Southern – Eastern Etosha National Park**

Another day to discover the mysteries of the African bush in Etosha National Park whilst travel in an easterly direction via Halali and Namutoni to Onguma Bushcamp.

**Overnight at Onguma Bush Camp or similar**

*Activities included: Excursion to Etosha National Park in touring vehicle*

*Meals included: breakfast & dinner*

**Day 12: Eastern Etosha National Park – Windhoek / End of Safari**

Return journey via Okahandja to Windhoek. Okahandja is an important centre for woodcarvers from the north. This is a good place to pick a last souvenir. Arrival in Windhoek will be around 17h00 with transfer to Hosea Kutako Airport for check-in on your outbound flight.
